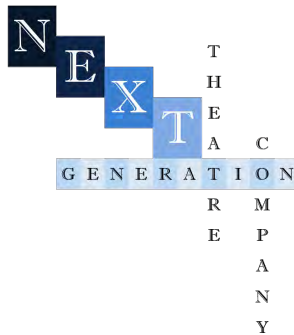

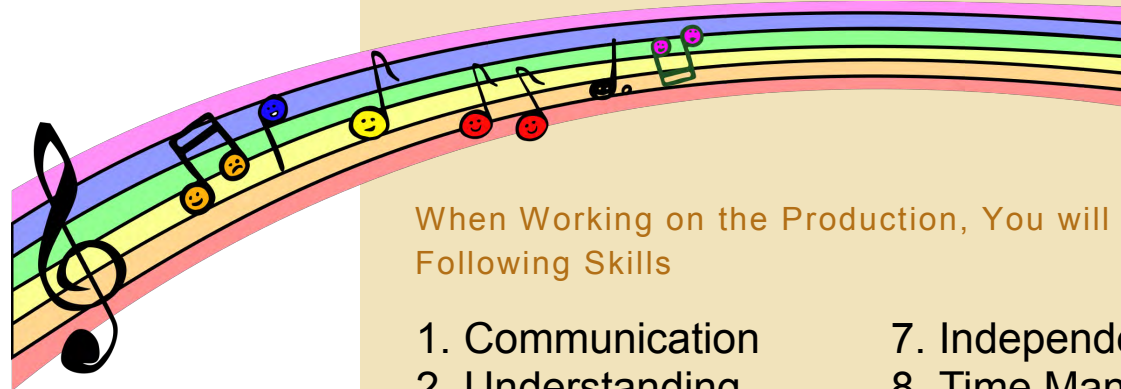
During this Week of Theater Camp you will:
